


November 2023 observations

- O The ongoing heavy rains in the nation triggered extreme weather events which include floods and heavy storms in the month of November.
- O The disasters affected a total of 38,547 individuals, representing 7.854 households while 15.962 individuals from 7.854 households were internally displaced.
- O Adults (19-64 years) were the most affected population group (52%), followed by children under 18 years (40%) and the elderly who were above 64 years (8%).
- O The most pressing needs are food assistance, NFI, Hygiene promotion among others
- O Houses partially damaged totaled 8,038 while 3,188 houses were completely destroyed. 416 water facilities, 84 health facilities and 64 schools were also affected.
- O Disasters have so far affected 215,299 individuals and displaced over 47,467 people as reported from January to September 2023.


Districts affected in 2023









Number of affected people by disasters in November 2023


